Catholic teens have energized parish life with their desire to participate in service, explore Scripture and experience new ways to pray. Their faith, passion and energy have a way of inspiring people of all ages. This Video Contest will provide a medium for their voice to be heard by using technology and visual media, which comes naturally to teens.

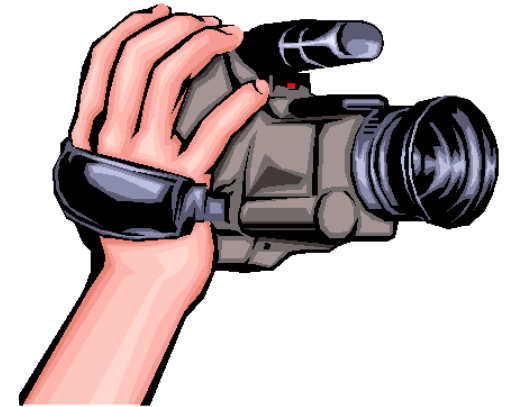
One goal in Youth Ministry and Catholic High School religion class is to understand that being a Christian disciple means "putting Jesus' teaching into practice." The video contest allows teens to proclaim what they have heard and seen and lived in their home.

ONE OR MORE

A video may be created by one individual or by a team of teens who agree to share the award money if they are given a first, second or third place award. For each of the winning videos, a matching amount will be sent to the Catholic parish, Catholic school or Catholic Church charitable organization (ex. food pantry, shelter, etc.) that is designated by the filmmaker(s). A panel of judges will award prize money to the teens who create the top three videos.

BE A DIGITAL DISCIPLE

The video contest provides teens with 3 ways to witness to their faith: sharing their story through *Handing on the Faith Reflection*, showing the video in a **PEER REVIEW** session and allowing the Archdiocese to post winning videos on the website and show them at parish events.
